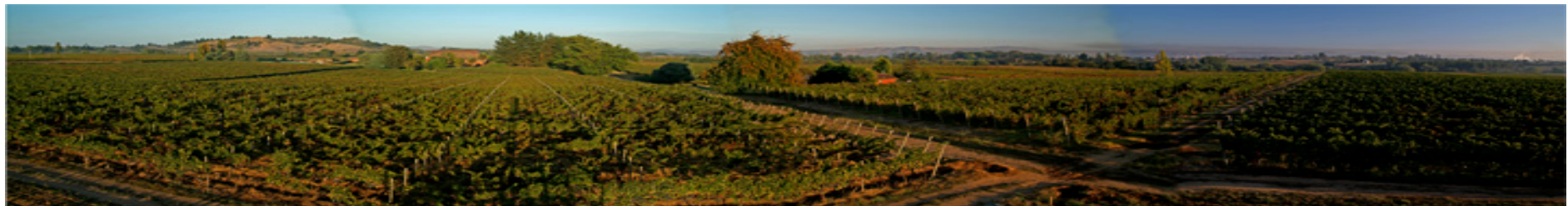




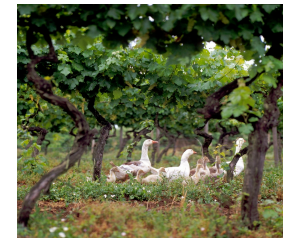
I. The Vineyard: Owned by French and one of the oldest vineyards in a blessed country with good land.

Casa Donoso is a special name with a special history. Michel Paoletti came to Chile in 1988 in search of a place with history and future potential. After searching all through Chile, what he found in the Maule Valley (just 280km south of Santiago) was more than he could have dreamed – a beautiful estate, with an expansive ‘Casona’ (the traditional Chilean colonial-style house) and well-established vines. The Maule Valley is home to the city of Talca. An important part of Chilean history, Talca was the site where the Chilean Act of Independence was signed in **1810**.

The estate was then owned by Lucia Donoso de Albuquerque. An extraordinary and charming woman, Lucia lived her entire life on the estate and when Michel gathered some good friends and wine enthusiasts from French Polynesia to collectively purchase the estate from Lucia in 1989, they named the winery in her honor – **Casa Donoso**. This pioneering group was amongst the first foreign investors to introduce modern technology to the winemaking industry in Chile. .

Our estates, La Oriental and Fundo Las Casas de Vaqueria are continuing the important and constantly evolving tradition of winemaking.

La Oriental, one of the oldest estates in Talca, has 110 planted hectares. Crowned by its Casona covering almost three thousand square meters, the estate has over 200 years of history. The soil here is volcanic with a medium level of fertility and naturally irrigated by waters, straight from the Andes mountain range. La Oriental is planted with a number of different varieties including Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc. Forty-seven hectares are dedicated to Cabernet Sauvignon vines that date back to more than 80 years.



Las Casas de Vaqueria currently has 55 hectares planted. Located at 35 km to the south of Talca, the estate is on the route to the coast. The coastal mountain range mixed with gentle ocean breezes, means Las Casas is blessed with perfect conditions for winemaking.

For the last three years at Las Casas, we have been working on organic vines, and are looking forward to producing our first organically certified wines for the 2009 harvest.



With over 20 years of experience, our business is to deliver the best quality wine possible. Eighty percent of the wines we produce are fine reds, and twenty percent are white wines with a production capacity of over 400,000 6-bottle cases per year. Our wine cellar, which dates back to the 1800s, is constantly being updated and modernized in order to ensure quality and consistency.

Ninety percent of all wines produced by Casa Donoso is exported to over 20 countries around the world including North America (USA and Canada), Europe (Great Britain, Belgium, Russia, Ireland, Germany...), Asia (Japan, China, Thailand, New Caledonia, Vietnam, Africa...), and of course, South America (Brazil, Colombia, Uruguay...)
